OPAL (Outdoor play and learning)

Welcome to our first blog all about playtime! We are Lily and Amayah. Something you might not know about Lily is she loves to roller skate! Something you might not know about Amayah is she plays the piano!



At school, we have started using OPAL playtimes [Outdoor Play and Learning.] During playtimes, we all got different equipment in each playground for example:

KS1- space hoppers, crates and tyres.

Amphitheatre- sand pit, chalk and trampolines.

KS2- tyres and cones.

Every playground have their own rules for all the equipment that we have to stick to in order to stay safe.

The rules are as follows:

Space hoops : no pushing , do not carry above the waist , no throwing and if there are crowds, move away, in order to stay as safe as possible.

Sandpit: no taking sand out of the sandpit, no throwing or swinging your hands round so no one gets sand in their eyes.

Chalk: no writing on the walls, no stepping on the chalk and no drawing on people's clothes.

Tyres: Do not carry above the waist, be careful not to bump into people, be careful about people around you, 1 person rolling and 2 people carrying.

Cones: Do not carry above the waist, do not throw around.

Trampolines: take your shoes off, no more than 1 person on except for reception, no more than 2 people, wait your turn in the line and don't push in.

Crates: no throwing, no carrying above waist, no jumping around and no swinging.

We also now have Wonderful Wednesdays. On Wednesdays, we can go to whatever playground we like, but the rules still stay the same. Instead of lining up on our spots, on Wednesdays, you go up to your class sensibly.
