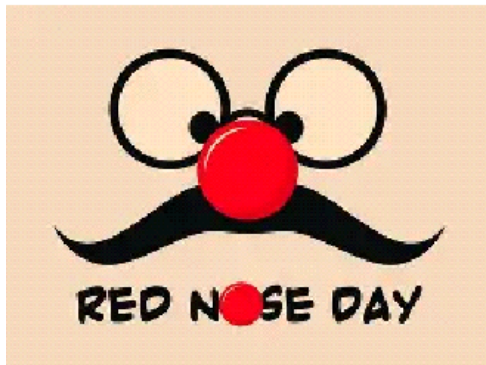


Welcome to the March Edition Blog.
