This newsletter gives you some information about what we will be learning over the coming weeks.

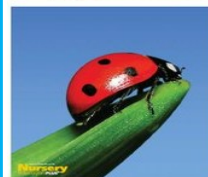
Topic

Our new topics for this half term are 'Minibeasts' and 'Plants and Growing'.

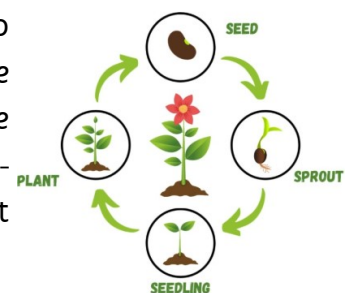


Minibeasts

Literacy

Our topic books this half term are:

'Aaarghhh Spider' and **'Lola Plants A Garden'**.

We will be drawing a story map which visually reinforces the series of events in the



book so that we can continue to develop repeating words or phrases from familiar stories in a variety of settings.

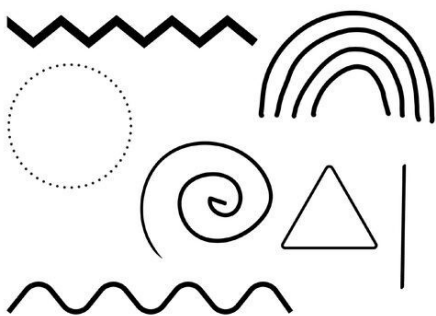
We will be continuing to learn a sound a week in Phonics, practicing hearing and verbally using that sound as well as recognising rhyming, syllables and initial sounds in words.

Mark Making

We will be building our control with joining lines, connecting straight or curved lines and strengthening our pencil grips. We use many mark making tools such as large crayons, felt tips, colouring pencils, chalk, water and paint.

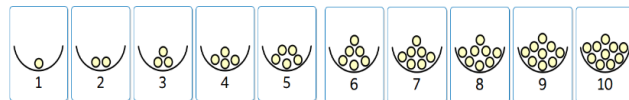
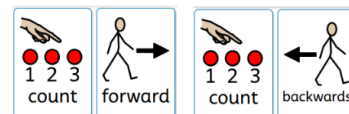
The children have been learning how to hold scissors and use them safely to cut lines in paper.

If you could encourage your child to continue to practise their scissor hold and cutting skills it would be appreciated.



Maths

We have lots to focus on this half term in maths! We are continuing to learn about 2D and 3D shapes, as well as exploring capacity. Every day we will count verbally to 10 and back.



We will learn to use 5 frames to support our counting and develop our abilities to make accurate sets.



Reminders

Please also ensure your child brings a sun hat, water bottle and has sun-cream already applied before school on sunny days.
